 Rake into a long line at the curb and we'll collect them throughout November, December, January and February. Please keep them separate from brush and tree limbs and away from storm drains.

Note: February collection is by request only. Submit an online service request at cityofrockhill.com or call 803-325-2500.

 Put leaves and brush into your YardCart for weekly pickup throughout the entire year.

 Compost your leaves in your backyard along with your grass clippings and turn it into a nutrient rich additive for your planting beds.

The City of Rock Hill is nationally recognized as a "Tree City USA" by the National Arbor Day Foundation. Along with all the city's trees comes a lot of leaves!

COLLECTION TIPS

- **During November, December and January, leaves and brush will be collected every other week. Please have leaves at the curb on Monday for pick up on your collection weeks.** Regular garbage and trash collection will remain on the regular weekly schedule.
- Rake leaves into a long line along the curb. Please do not bag leaves; they must be delivered loose to the grinding facility.
- Be sure leaves are separated from other yard debris and trash.
- Try to avoid piling leaves in front of mailboxes or utility poles and guy wires.
- Avoid piling leaves in front of storm drains or on top of utility accesses (water meters, irrigation systems, etc.).
- Do not blow leaves into storm drains or put them in creeks. Penalties with fines up to \$1,000 will be enforced.
- Blocking traffic lanes or creating line-of-sight hazards for motorists can result in liabilities to the home owner.

Note: Schedule subject to change based on volume.

Leaves will be collected by tractors or vacuum machines. It is important that leaves are raked into a long line at the curb so the leaf vacuum and tractors can collect them.

Leaves must be free of trash and other yard debris such as tree limbs or rocks. Tree limbs and other debris can clog the vacuum and damage the equipment. If you have brush to be collected please place it in a separate pile at the curb away from leaf piles.

Leaves and brush can also be placed in your YardCart year round.

YES! Please rake leaves into a long line at the curb.

NO! Please do NOT bag leaves.

Please do not bag leaves. They must be delivered to the grinding facility loose and free of other yard debris and trash.
